

Justice Magray visits Baramulla, takes stock of functioning of Munsif Court Boniyar

Pendency of cases beyond five to ten years to be disposed on priority

Baramulla, June, 26:- Jammu and Kashmir High Court Justice and Administrative Judge for Baramulla district Ali Mohammad Magray today visits Munsif Court Boniyar, Uri to take stock of functioning of the court.

He inspects various facilities available for litigating public and lawyers. Justice Magray offered patient hearing to the demands and grievances of advocates and instructed the concerned to initiate efforts towards their immediate redressal.

The purpose of the visit to Munsif court Boniyar by Administrative Judge is to ensure speedy, inexpensive and timely disposal of pending cases for litigating public by judiciary. Enhance endeavors with reference to disposal of cases in line with the mandate of the law. Encourage Alternative Dispute Redressal Mechanism outside routine procedural mechanism for putting in mediation for reconciliation.

Administrative Judge, Justice Magray instructed all concerned to expedite disposal of pending cases with special emphasis on disposal of cases pending from last five to ten years. He called for strict compliance with recently prepared Action Plan for disposal of pending cases to meet the challenges of docket explosion.

During his visit, Justice Magray also inspected ADR and Mediation mechanisms and emphasized on disposal of pending cases through ADR where both parties may have win-win situation without wasting time and money if their dispute is resolved amicably.

“People have faith in judiciary and the need of the hour is to put in coordinated efforts to strengthen confidence so that justice is not only done but seen to be done” said Justice Magray.

Later, Justice Magray reviews the functioning of traffic management and regulatory system wherein he stressed for strict compliance of traffic rules and regulations. He directs the District Mobile Magistrate Traffic Jehangir Bakshi to adhere on such regulations so that hassle free movement of the public is ensured. He also inspects the records leisure and reviews the performance achieved previously.
