

ISM organizes awareness prog on “National AYUSH Mission” at Baramulla

Baramulla, 12 March: A day long awareness programme on “National AYUSH mission” was today organized at Dak Bungalow Baramulla with Member Legislative Assembly Baramulla Javeed Hasan Beigh as the chief guest. Programme was organized by Directorate of Indian System of Medicine which marked the participation of various doctors, ASHA workers and other functionaries of Health and other departments.
