

## **CEO Niti Aayog Visits B'la, Inaugurates Dialysis Centre at DH, Computer Lab at GHSS**

### ***Amitab Kant Reviews transformation of B'la under "Aspirational District" Prog***

Baramulla, 13 October: Chief Executive Officer NITI AYOGE Amitab Kant today inaugurated Dialysis Centre under Pradhan Mantri National Dialysis Programme at District Hospital Baramulla during a visit to the District. The CEO also inaugurated the Computer Laboratory at Government Boys Higher Secondary School Baramulla. The lab has been equipped with 22 computer systems besides having smart classroom for interactive learning.

Later the CEO convened a meeting at Dak Bungalow to assess the progress being made in Baramulla under the central government's 'Transformation of Aspirational Districts' programme.

The meeting was attended by Principal Secretary Planning Rohit Kaunsal, Prabhari Officer Farooq Ahmad Lone, DDC Baramulla Dr Nasir Ahmad Naqash, Director School Education Kashmir Dr G N Itoo, Director Horticulture Manzoor Ahmad Qadri, Director Planning A G Malik, heads of various departments besides other officers from the district.
