

## **DDC Reviews arrangements for Gram Swaraj Abhiyan**

### ***Different events to be observed from 14 April to 05 May under the campaign***

Baramulla, 10 April: In order to finalize the arrangements for the upcoming Gram Swaraj Abhiyan to be observed from 14th of April to 5th of May 2018, a meeting of officers was today chaired by District Development Commissioner Dr Nasir Ahmad Naqash here at Dak Bungalow.
